Deliverables/Activities:

- Review the Ontario Accord and Living & Serving <https://ontarioaidsnetwork.ca/living-serving/>
- Analyze key informant interviews and surveys, synthesizing invaluable insights on GIPA/MEPA progress in Ontario.
- Draft a community-informed version of Living and Serving 4, featuring 10–12 recommendations—think organizational standards, accountability tools, and resources to empower action.
- Ensure that diversity, equity, and inclusion is at the centre of this process
- Draft a summary with key actions each individual, agency, and the OAN can take to strengthen GIPA/MEPA
- Collaborate with the Advisory Committee of People Living with HIV to get feedback and guide the process
- Optional: Lead key informant interviews (20–30 sessions) to fill gaps in current data—hear diverse voices, share varying perspectives, and enrich the narrative.

Skills, Experience, and Expertise:

- A deep connection to GIPA/MEPA frameworks and their implementation across Ontario's ASOs.
- Profound understanding of the intersections between HIV stigma, disclosure, systems of oppression and racism
- Exceptional qualitative and quantitative research analysis skills.
- A gift for transforming complex concepts into crystal-clear, plain-language content.
- Superb project management, communication, and organizational finesse.
