We are seeking a full-time Executive Director (ED) to provide leadership for the agency as we move to a new stage of sustainable, dynamic work in this culturally diverse region. The ED is the Board of Directors' single link to the operating organization and is in charge of all aspects of organizational performance. Responsible for the overall leadership and management of PHAN, the ED ensures the development, delivery and evaluation of all aspects of agency programs and services. PHAN is currently funded by the Federal, Provincial and Municipal government as well as private and corporate donors. PHAN currently has a staff of 9 including the ED, a full-time Administration and Finance Coordinator and program staff who provide programming and support in the areas of African, Caribbean and Black (ACB) Health Promotion, PHA Support, Harm Reduction, Men's Health Promotion and Women's Community Development.
